

CONVERTING PILOTS

RAAus to GA

Conversion to an GA Recreational Pilots License can be made from an RAAus RPC

In order to convert to a CASA Recreational Pilots License you must:

- 1) Be at least 16 years of age
- 2) Completed at least 25 hours of flight time as pilot of an aircraft in the associated category, including:
 - (a) -at least 20 hours of dual flight time; and
 - (b) -at least 5 hours of solo flight time.
- 3) Hold a current class 1 or class 2 medical, or a commercial driver medical (restrictions apply)
- 4) Complete an English proficiency assessment
- 5) Hold or have applied for an ASIC or AVID card
- 6) Submitted a CASA Form 61-9PIC
- 7) Pass a flight review mentioned in Part 61 of the Manual of Standards
- 8) If you wish to transfer your NAV Endorsement you will need to undertake a Nav Assessment flight and perform 2Hrs of Instrument Flight (1 of which can be in our simulator)
